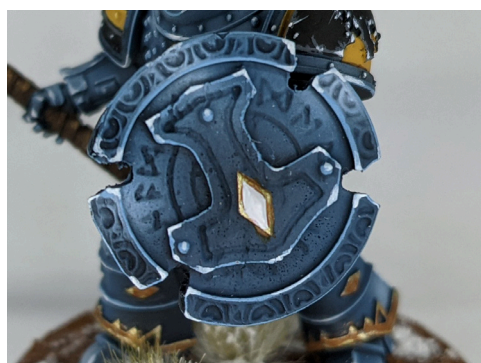

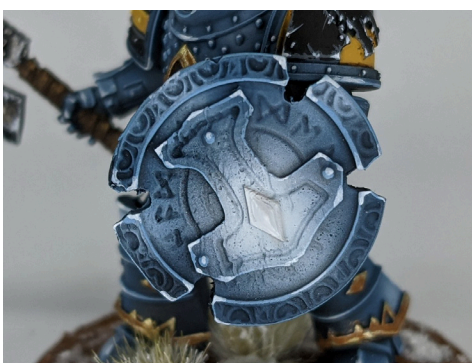
How to paint a glowing effect on a gemstone

This tutorial shows how to paint a reddish luminous effect on a gem, in a quick and easy way. A miniature from the "Sons of Thor" range by Kromlech has been used.

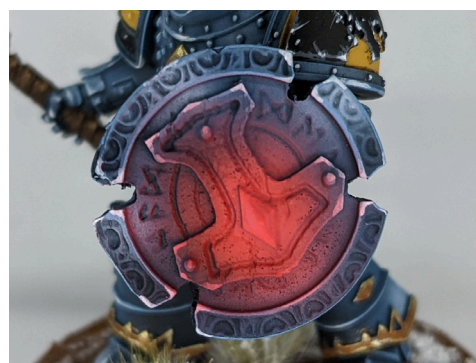

1 The gemstone is painted using Model Color White 70.951.



2 Using the airbrush, paint the outside of the gemstone with Game Air Dead White 72.701.



3 The gemstone and the surrounding area are painted with Game Ink Red 72.086 with the airbrush.



4 To increase the intensity; paint the entire gem with a brush using Model Color Fluorescent Orange 70.733.



5 To enhance the vividness of this area; paint the area between the frames of the gemstone and its edges. For this, Model Color White 70.951 will be used.



6 On top of the white color, Model Color Fluorescent Orange 70.733 is applied again, increasing its intensity on the inner side.



7 A thin line of Model Color White 70.951 is carefully applied, keeping the area of application quite small.



8 Finally, a mixture of Model Color Fluorescent Orange 70.733 and Model Color Fluorescent Yellow 70.730 is applied over this thin white line, creating a stronger luminous effect.
